Day 4: Endicott Arm Dawes Glacier (Cruising)

Visitors travel to Alaska to witness magnificent glaciers like Dawes Glacier, and the journey there is part of the thrill. From Stephens Passage, your ship enters the quieter Endicott Arm, sister to Tracy Arm, where a 31-mile fjord reveals sheer granite cliffs, cascading waterfalls, and spruce and hemlock trees clinging to steep mountainsides.

Along the way, look for sculpted “bergy bits” of floating ice, sometimes with seals resting on them, as well as bears, mountain goats, and whales. Nearing the glacier, listen for thunderous cracks as this active tidewater giant calves massive slabs into the sea. Rising about 600 feet high and half a mile wide, its striking blue face is a true highlight of any Alaska cruise.

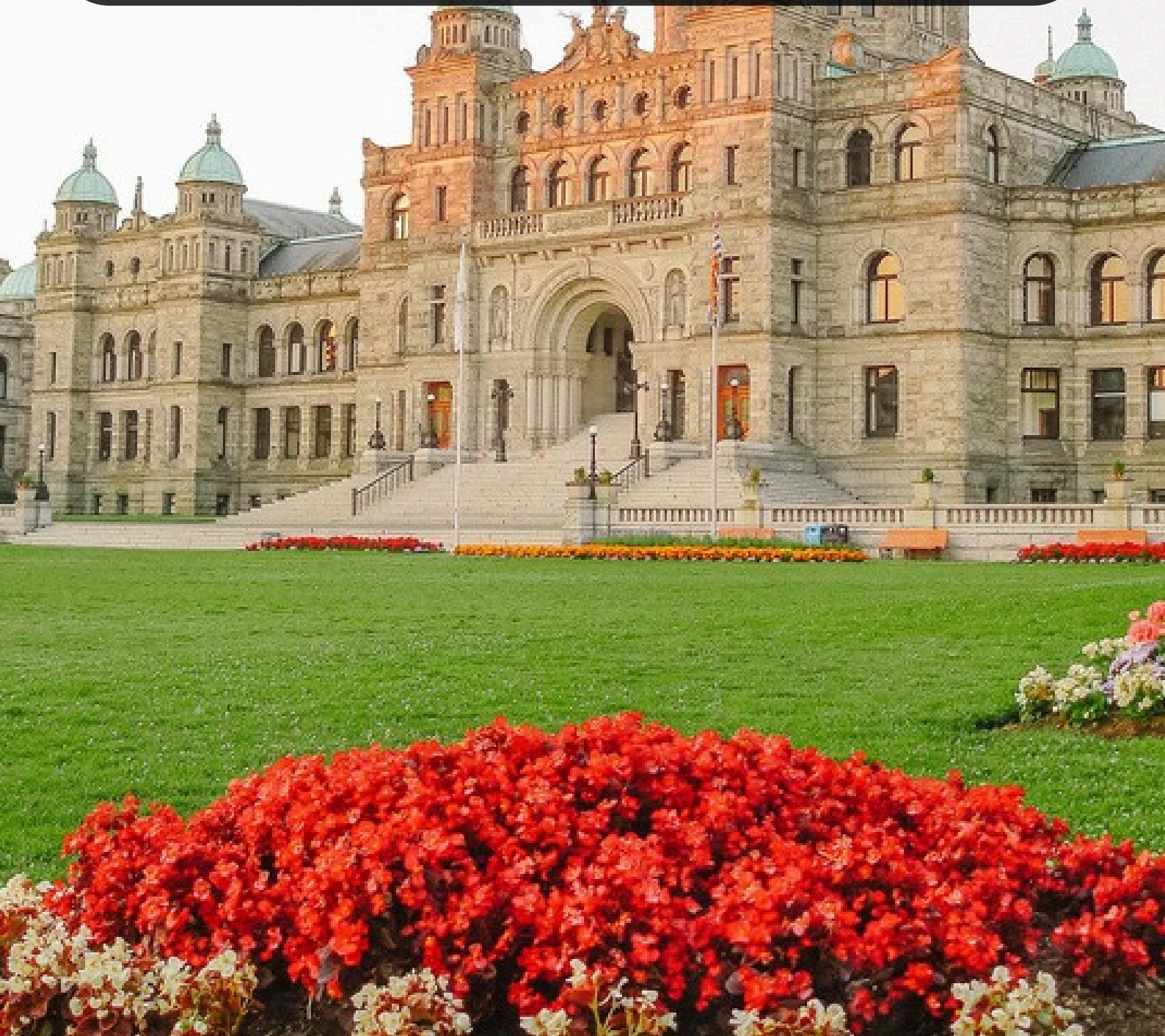
